(j) Maready Graveyard, in Area D.
(k) Goronto Graveyard, in Area D. It is the intention of the Navy to remove the white bodies in these graveyards to a new site on U.S. Highway No. 24, just East of the corporate limits of the Town of Jack sonville and adjacent to the present white city cemetery. The colored bodies will be moved to a new site. on U. S. Highway No. 17, just North of the Town of Verona.

Any party desiring to raise object. tions to the order as entered by the County Board of Commissioners of Onslow County is hereby notified to file said objections in writing with said Board within thirty (80) days from the date of this notice.
